



Barn Rules for 2026

1. No cigarette or cigar smoking in the barns.
2. All horses must wear breakaway halters in stalls, if they wear halters. Wearing of halters is preferred.
3. No horse is to be left unattended on crossties in aisle or with stall doors open (including French doors). No stall webbing or guards are allowed on stalls.
4. ASTM/SEI Helmets to be worn by riders 18 years and under. If you do not ride with a helmet, you must have written consent of parent or guardian. Riders must wear proper boots. No one is allowed in barns in any type of sandal wear or open toed shoes.
5. No unattended children are allowed under the age of 14 without supervision of parent or guardian.
6. There will be no riding in the barns at any time. No double riding.
7. Do not block doorways or driveways.
8. All owners, riders, trainers, and farriers are required to clean up after themselves. Manure should be dumped on pile, not in garbage.
9. All door of barn must be closed at all times when temperature is under 32 degrees.
10. In an emergency, a vet will be called at your expense if you cannot be reached or your designated vet.
11. A signed boarding contract, release slip and a signed rules statement must be in office.
12. Shavings are given out on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays only.
13. If you bring friends or relatives, they must abide by the rules of the barn.
14. Board is due by the 5th of the month. Any board paid past the 25th will be subject to a \$25.00 late fee.
15. Boarders are required to check with management before moving tack in tack rooms; no items are to be left on the floors of the tack room. No feed is to be left in tack room, as that attracts vermin.
16. Arena and trail courtesy should be recognized at all times. Those riders who are taking a lesson will get priority of the arena. All riders who are walking need to ride off the rail when others are in the arena.
17. Help your fellow boarders and riders. Always try to work together. Infighting, gossiping, and general poor behavior towards others will not be tolerated.
18. Be respectful of others' property. If you borrow something, put it back where you found it.
19. Please turn off the lights if you are last one in the barn, as well as turn off arena lights if you are last one in the arena.
20. Please be mindful of closing time.
21. Always use a lead rope when moving your horse about the facility.
22. All lessons are to be with current staff only. No outside trainers or farriers are allowed on premises. Any other health professional must have current insurance paperwork in office prior to coming on property.
23. All damage done to stalls and turnout pens by the client's horses will be repaired at the owner's expense. Horses that crib or kick will be required to wear a collar or chains.
24. Speed limit is 5 mph for everyone on the farm.
25. No lunging of horses during a class.
